

GUIDELINES FOR SPARC CENTER

Participants are expected to practice appropriate behavior at all times in all places of the property of SPARC and Yard birds Mall.

The following guidelines have been developed to ensure the SAFETY and ENJOYMENT for everyone. Additional guidelines may be added as situations arise.

- Participants should be 18 years or older. Younger participation may be allowed at the supervisor's discretion, if he/she has appropriate social skills for group interaction.
- Your Application information needs updated immediately, if anything changes.
- Participants may bring a snack. Water will be available. Activities that involve food, will be indicated on the schedule.
- Participants must have transportation to and from center. Volunteers will not be asked to provide rides. Rides need to be arranged for pickup. No exceptions!

EXPECTED BEHAVIOR OF PARTICIPANTS:

- Participants must come prepared to participate in activities.
- Show respect and get along with all participants and staff.
- Follow staff/leaders directions and instructions at class, events, trips, etc.
- Be respectful of equipment, supplies facilities and presenters.
- Dress appropriately for the day of activities
- No foul language is permitted.
- No physical harm to others or yourself allowed.
- No intimate physical contact with others.
- No use of recreational drugs or alcohol on site.
- Participants are not allowed to ask for money or personal items of others.

GUIDELINES VIOLATIONS/DISCIPLINE:

A positive approach will be used; each situation will be evaluated and may face suspension. The supervisor reserves the right to dismiss individuals from the program.

BATHROOM SAFETY/LIABILITY

- Volunteers must not assist participants with bathroom in any way.
- No two participants are allowed in the bathroom at one time.
- Chaperones can stand in or near the doorway-in the public eye at all times.
